A father has been heartbreakingly given 12 months to live after a 'stabbing pain' in his head ended up being brain cancer.

Mark Downey, 45, was struck with an excruciating headache while driving with his family to a holiday in Wales in September 2023.

The HGV driver, from Bolton, went to A&E after painkillers were not helping but left after he faced a 17-hour wait to see a doctor.

After visiting his GP at home, who referred him for an MRI scan, he was eventually diagnosed with glioblastoma, a type of fast-growing brain tumour that can carry a life expectancy of just 12 to 18 months from diagnosis.

Feeling 'too strong' to give up, Mr Downey and his partner of 23 years, Samantha Scott, 39, are now raising money to fund private treatment.

Two days before their family holiday to Kinnel Bay in North Wales, Mr Downey had noticed he had a headache but didn't think much of it.

He knew something wasn't right when he experienced a 'stabbing pain' in the right side of his head while driving his family to Wales.

'The pain in my head was so sharp I tried to pull my head the other way because it felt like something was banging into it,' he said.

'I took painkiller after painkiller and the headache just did not go.'

The pain was so excruciating that it made the father-of-three sick.

On the first day of the family's trip, he called 111 and was told to go to A&E.

But once in hospital Mr Downey was told it would be a 17 hour wait to see a doctor.

Mr Downey and Ms Scott decided to take the risk and drive home, with their son set to start secondary school that Monday.

The next day on September 4, he went to see his GP and he was sent straightaway for a brain scan at the Bolton Royal Hospital, which showed he had a bleed on the brain.

The following day he had an MRI which revealed he had a brain tumour.

Doctors initially didn't realise how severe it was and thought it was a stage two brain tumour, Mr Downey claims.

WHAT IS A GLIOBLASTOMA?

Glioblastomas are the most common cancerous brain tumours in adults.

Pete made a lasting impact both on this program and within our Georgetown community which will never be forgotten."

A young father has tragically died from a brain tumour just days after his perfect beach wedding.

Rikki Tako, 32, passed away on March 26, a week after marrying Nykala Garrett near New Plymouth, in **New Zealand**.

Ms Garrett had recently given up her job as a nurse at Taranaki Base Hospital in December last year to care for Mr Tako.

He began experiencing seizures, memory loss, and headaches while he was recovering from a head injury sustained in a workplace accident.

However tests showed he had an aggressive and incurable **cancer** known as a brain stem glioblastoma, which can cause headaches, a loss of balance, weakness on one side of the face and difficulty walking.

The tumour was pre-existing but it was believed the workplace accident led to its rapid growth, and had that not happened the tumour likely would not have been a problem for another 20 years.

Ms Garrett previously said she was 'speechless', especially at the time when she was told her partner could have just weeks to live.

'I just wasn't expecting it to blow up as well as it did. The generosity has been insane,' she told **Stuff**.

'Just with how hard the economy has been hit at the moment, it's so amazing how generous people still are.'

Anand Acharya passed away peacefully at home on March 3, 2024 at the age of 55, after an almost **two-year battle with brain cancer** surrounded by his wife and daughters. Two days prior to his passing, when the doctor asked him how he was doing he told her with all sincerity that “he was living his best life ever”. While he reached great heights in his professional life including being a Captain in the RCAF on the C130, obtaining a PhD in Economics from Carleton and being an Air Canada pilot on the Boeing 777, the thing he was most proud of was his family which he always made his top priority. He is survived by his wife (Kusum), his daughters (Nina and Jasmine), his sister (Anjali) and his parents (Padma and Jana). His wish was to be remembered and not mourned. To this end, a Remembrance of Life will be held at the Beechwood National Memorial Centre, 280 Beechwood Avenue, Ottawa on Sunday, March 10th, 2024 from 12:00 to 3:00 pm.

Born in Cranford, Callaghan graduated from Mount Olive High School in 2012, her obituary reads. She graduated from East Carolina University with a degree in nutrition and dietetics and later achieved her master's in nutrition from St. Elizabeth University, according to her obituary.

Callaghan was diagnosed with brain cancer in March 2023, according to a [fundraiser](#) set up to support her medical bills. As of Thursday, March 7, more than \$106,000 had been raised.

A registered dietician, Callaghan enjoyed the outdoors, traveling and music, her obituary reads. Callaghan is survived by her parents, Kathleen and Timothy, her sisters, Katie and Claire and her partner, Ryan, among other family members and friends, according to her obituary.

Feb. 15, 2024 - 22 year old Alexis Buchman, Former USF Softball Player and Tampa native. In Fall 2021: Diagnosed Brain Cancer, and died 2 years later on February 15, 2024.

"It is devastating to lose a teammate, friend, and beloved member of our Bulls family," USF Softball Head Coach [Ken Eriksen](#) said. "Alexis was a light in all the lives she touched and was truly courageous and inspiring in her fight. Our thoughts and prayers are with her parents, Steven and Kris, and family. We were blessed to have Alexis in our lives and to learn from her example of grace and determination. Her memory will long live within our program."

Buchman was diagnosed with brain cancer in the fall of 2021. During treatment, she remained an active member of the softball team, serving as a student manager through the 2023 season.

Mum given just 14 months to live after collapsing in front of kids while cooking

Danielle Camilleri, 40, was given the devastating news she has a stage four glioblastoma tumour just months after marrying her partner of 17 years, Brian

A mum-of-two had the shock of her life when she collapsed just three months after her partner proposed to her on her 40th birthday.

Danielle Camilleri and partner Brian, who have been together for 17 years and share two children, were in the midst of planning their wedding when the incident occurred.

While cooking at home with her kids, Charlie-Grace, 10, and seven-year-old Amias, Danielle suddenly dropped a spoon, lost control of her arm and fell to the floor. Her sister, Gabrielle Canham, shared: "I'd been talking to her on the phone about her wedding plans when it happened. It was terrifying for the children but luckily Brian came through the door and they ran for help from neighbours. Brian had to prise Danielle's mouth open and give her CPR."

Danielle, who runs a nursery in Cardiff, was quickly taken to the University Hospital of Wales where a CT scan revealed a shadow on her brain. An MRI scan confirmed it was a tumour. Gabrielle told **Wales Online**: "There had been absolutely not one tell-tale sign she was gravely ill. We had no idea," adding, "It was only when she had the fit and collapsed at home."

The couple rushed to plan their wedding in just 27 days, saying "I do" in front of 110 guests at Llantilio House, Monmouthshire. Danielle later had a four-hour operation to remove the tumour, but it had grown quickly and she was diagnosed with a stage four glioblastoma tumour.

Danielle, from Llandaff, Cardiff, is now having chemotherapy and radiotherapy. Her family are also trying to raise £250,000 for a treatment not currently available on the **NHS**.

BBC Scotland's political editor has revealed that he has incurable [brain cancer](#).

Glenn Campbell said he feels "as lucky as someone in my position can be" following the diagnosis, and believed he would live for a "long time yet".

The 47-year-old said that after a [brain tumour](#) was discovered, he was told the "most likely scenario" was that it was [glioblastoma](#), a fast-growing and aggressive form of cancer with an average life expectancy of 12 to 18 months.

However, after surgeons removed most of the tumour, the said biopsies revealed that he instead had a "rare type of tumour" which "tends to respond better to treatment than many other types".

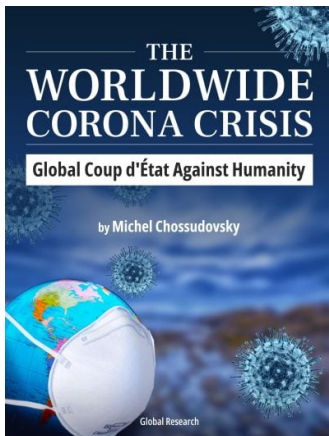
